WHY ARE SENIOR PORTRAITS DIFFERENT?

Senior portraits are typically of better quality than an underclassman school portrait. They require more time to shoot and process.

I ALREADY HAD MY PORTRAIT TAKEN WITH LIFETOUCH THIS SUMMER!

Great! You don't need to do anything else. They will give us your portrait in the correct format. You can disregard the rest of this flyer.

IS THERE A SENIOR PORTRAIT DAY DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR?

Yes, it is scheduled for THIS THURSDAY, August 18. This is considered the make-up day for students who did not schedule over the summer. It will be the last chance - there is NO make-up day for this make-up day!

I HAD A PROBLEM WITH MY SCHOOL PORTRAITS LAST YEAR.

Many people had problems with the portraits produced by last year's photo studio. For that reason, we now use Lifetouch instead.

WHAT IF I WANT TO USE A DIFFERENT STUDIO?

By using Lifetouch, your picture will look consistent with those of your classmates, and it will be on time to us and in the correct format. However, we will accept portraits from outside studios if they are of professional studio quality and meet the specifications below—NO AMATEUR PHOTOS ACCEPTED. Make sure that you bring this handout to outside studios so they can follow correct specifications. If they do not follow these specifications, we cannot print your portrait. NO EXCEPTIONS.

DEADLINE FOR OUTSIDE STUDIOS

Make sure we have your portrait on CD by Sept. 30. No **printed** portraits.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR OUTSIDE STUDIOS

Lifetouch (our official school studio) customers do not need this information.

Submission format:	Digital (300 dpi JPG) – NO HARD COPIES
Picture size:	2" w x 3" h
Spacing:	.25" between top of head and top of picture
Head size:	1.5" high x 1" w
Background:	Light gray (Sierra Gray)
Pose:	Eyes level with horizon, slightly tilted head (no looking over the shoulder!)
Boys' clothing:	Black tuxedo, white shirt and black bow tie
Girls' clothing:	Black drape, no cleavage. Pearl necklace recommended. Make sure drape is visible in portrait.
Jewelry:	No piercings or jewelry that distract from the face.
